Highlights from Grade 6

February came and went, filled with events and opportunities to make learning memories. We wrapped up our hands-on work with Air and Aerodynamics and are well into our study of flight and how to maximize the effects of drag, lift and resistance. Our practice paid off for Hannah Warford who was able to get her airplane at Hockey Night in Alix right to the Face-Off dot. We are busy testing parachute and glider design as we wrap up the unit on Flight.

This month we will head up to Edmonton to explore the Alberta Aviation Museum and the Alberta Legislature. These field trip opportunities, subsidized by F.A.M.S., allow us to see, firsthand, some of Alberta's history and explore the role that both of these places play in our current day.

We continue to explore the roles that local and provincial government play in the daily lives of the students and their families while looking closely at how these governing bodies apply the steps to effective problem solving.
